

SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2018-2019 Third and Fourth Grade

GENERAL

- Book covers 2 Large for Social Studies and Reading
- pouch for back of desk (made of sturdy material) ---directions for sewing one are on back---
(if you do not sew -- Mrs. Fischer will take orders during summer)
- ruler - with inches and centimeters
- #2 pencils (8 pencils to start the year with)
- 3 red pens
- pencil pouch in which to store pencils
- eraser
- 2 pocket folders—one for take home folder, one for stay at school
(plastic holds up best)
- 1 ---3 prong **plastic** pocket folder **Green**
- 1 3-ring binder Hard Cover (1" spine)—for religion lessons
- 5 dry erase markers
- 1 Highlighter (yellow Preferred)
- 2 packages of wide ruled lined paper
- 4 **composition** style notebooks (No wired notebooks)
- Protractor (4th Grade only)
- 1 large box of tissues
- 3 Containers of Anti-Bacterial wipes
- 1 box gallon zip lock storage bags (4th grade) 1 box sandwich size zip lock storage bags (3rd Grade)
- 1 pair of ear buds for personal use or may use head phones—store them in a plastic zip bag

ART SUPPLIES

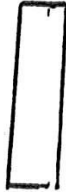
- 2 Black Sharpie pens
- 1 #2 pencil (sharpened)
- 1 box colored pencils (Crayola) (no larger than 24 count)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (to be used for colored pencils)
- 1 soft "Art Gum" / pink eraser
- 24 count crayons (Crayola)
- 1 pair pointed FISKARS scissors (choose pair to fit your child's hand size)
- 6 glue sticks (should last all year)
- Wide – line markers (classic colors)
- fine-tip colored markers – Classic colors (no more than 12 count)
- 1 Elmer's 4 oz. Glue
- 1 Crayola Water Color Set



AN ART BOX WILL BE SUPPLIED BY THE SCHOOL

Need: Desk Back Pack
1 yd. of 45" wide material

- ① Take the material and fold it lengthwise with right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam.



- ② You should have a 45" long piece of material that is inside out - turn it right side out.

3. Sew the top of one side together by folding in a $\frac{1}{4}$ " and stitching across.



fold in $\frac{1}{4}$ "
stitch across

fold in and
sew across the bottom
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " IN AS WELL.

4. Now fold the material in thirds like a fan.



- ⑤ After it's folded, then sew $\frac{1}{2}$ " down both sides through all three thicknesses.
